Description of "Owner Will Maintain" area:

By submitting this request I hereby understand and agree that:

- Franklin County WILL NOT apply herbicide, or implement other means, to control weeds at the locations described above and shown on the attached map; and
- Owner will install "Owner Will Maintain" signs at the beginning and ending edge of the area per County standards. Signs shall be placed perpendicular to and be clearly visible from the driving lane. Signs shall be placed a minimum of ten (10) feet from the edge of pavement or gravel surface. The owner shall be responsible for replacement of loss or damaged signs. Failure to replace signs may result in inadvertent herbicide application; and
- The owner shall control all vegetation within the road right of way in a manner consistent with the Franklin County Weed Control Program. Failure to control vegetation in an appropriate manner voids this agreement and the property will be returned to the weed control program; and
- Franklin County reserves the right to take immediate action, without notice, when the owner's failure to maintain the area(s) creates a threat to public safety; and

This agreement is:

Permanent: Will not expire unless county is notified

Annual: Expires on December 31, 20_____

Performance under this Agreement is at owners sole risk and that owner shall indemnify Franklin County, its agents and employees, hold them harmless from any and all liability for damages, costs, losses, and expenses resulting from, arising out of, or in any way connected with this Agreement, or from owners failure to perform fully hereunder. Owner further agrees to defend Franklin County, its agents and employees, against all suits, actions, or proceedings brought by any third party against them or which owner would be liable hereunder.
