



Congratulations on becoming a candidate!

Now What?

You have two deadlines approaching very quickly:

1. **Tuesday, May 21, 4:30pm-** Candidate statements and photos for the online voter guide are due no later than 4:30pm on Tuesday, May 21. There are no exceptions to this deadline. After submitting your Declaration of Candidacy, you should have received an email with a link where you can submit your candidate statement and photo. Please contact our office if you need any assistance.
2. **Two weeks from the day you became a candidate.** If you are a candidate for an office that requires PDC reporting, you may have to start filing reports right away: www.pdc.wa.gov

Voter Guide

Franklin County prints and posts an online voter guide for both the Primary and General Elections.

There is a limit of **200 words**, and your statement and photo must be in our office no later than Tuesday, May 21, at 4:30pm. Detailed rules can be found on your candidate guidebook.

Other Dates and Deadlines

May 13 **Lot drawing.** This random drawing determines the placement of candidate names within a contest on the ballot. The lot drawing will be held at 11 am at the elections department located at 1016 N 4th Ave, in Pasco.

May 13 **Last day for candidates to withdraw.** Filing fees are not refundable and the request to withdraw must be submitted to the Franklin County Elections Department no later than 5pm.
